



Rural Arizona Action Responds to Censure of U.S. Rep. Paul Gosar

The U.S. House of Representatives Wednesday voted to censure Rep. Paul Gosar after he posted a video on social media depicting him killing Rep. Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez and attacking President Joe Biden. Rural Arizona Action **Co-Executive Director Natali Fierros Bock** released the following statement.

"The House of Representatives was right to censure Rep. Paul Gosar. His violent rhetoric against colleagues has no place in our political discourse and is not representative of who we are as rural Arizonans. By posting an egregious and dangerous video, Rep. Gosar prioritized himself instead of his constituents. It is the people of Arizona who now lose representation on the committees to which he was assigned."

As a result of the censure, Gosar will be stripped of his assignments on the Committee on Oversight and Reform and the Natural Resources Committee.
